Subject: Grant in aid under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Multi sectoral development programme for minorities to Government of Uttar Pradesh for the year 2008-09 for Barabanki District.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President for release of an amount of Rs. 8,39,64,000 (Rupees eight crore thirty nine lakhs & sixty four thousand only) as 1<sup>st</sup> instalment (50% of total central share) of the total sanctioned amount of Rs. 16,79,29,000.00 (Rupees sixteen crore seventy nine lakhs & twenty nine thousand only) for the year 2008-09 to the Govt. of Uttar Pradesh for implementation of the scheme "Multi sectoral development programme for minorities" for Barabanki district as per details enclosed at Annexure. ### Indira Awas Yojana (IAY)

- The State Government should ensure that the IAY houses would be distributed in villages having highest minority population and BPL families selected from the approved waiting list, even if they belonged to communities other than the minority communities, strictly in order of their ranking in the list as per the IAY guidelines.
- State share would be provided.
- The list of the villages, along with the number of houses to be constructed, would be furnished by the State Government.
- To prevent duplication, the Government of Uttar Pradesh should ensure that the IAY units funded under MsDP were reflected in the State Action Plan of the scheme and the Central Ministry concerned informed.

### Construction of building of Primary Health Sub-Centres (PHSC)

- The State Government should ensure that the centres were located in areas having the highest concentration of minority population.
- NRHM construction norms, design, specification would be followed and the State share would be provided.
- The list of the centres with location should be furnished.
- To prevent duplication, the Government of Uttar Pradesh should ensure that the centres funded under MsDP were reflected in the State Action Plan of the scheme and the Central Ministry informed.
